COVID-SAFE PLAN – Travel with the Kings of Newcastle

The health, safety and well-being of our passengers and staff is and always has been our number one priority. In line with guidance from transport regulators as well as the Australian Government we are implementing a range of Travel Safe measures to mitigate the risk of COVID-19.

Foremost, passengers showing symptoms of COVID-19 are requested to cancel their tour prior to date of departure. Should you become unable to travel, ticket price for day tours and theatre concerts **MAY** be transferrable depending on individual supplier regulations, yet coach content must be entirely forfeited and is strictly non-refundable.

Kings Coaches supports the implementation of physical distancing measures wherever possible and has implemented several control measures to reduce the risk of passengers being exposed to the virus. Passengers should always follow the guidance provided by Kings Coaches. If you have any questions, please ask the driver before boarding. Our business COVIDSafe Plan is accessible for customers to read through upon request.

Kings Coaches will not be liable for any transmission of COVID-19 while passengers are travelling on our vehicles. We reserve the right to refuse travel to any passenger who is believed to be in contradiction to Federal Government advice, including those showing signs and symptoms of illness.

Face Masks: Wearing a mask can help protect you and those around you if you are in an area with community transmission, and physical distancing is not possible, like on board transport services. We recommend that clients wear face masks on board. Disposable surgical masks are available to purchase from our office prior to departure.

Physical Distancing: The Department of Health continues to encourage everyone to keep at least 1.5 metres apart from others (outside of their family unit) where possible.

Driver PPE: All drivers are issued with personal protective equipment including disposable gloves for manual handling, sanitising wipes and hand sanitiser. All the staff at Kings Coaches are trained in Infection Control of COVID-19 by the Australian Government, Department of Health.

Temperature Checking: All passengers may have their temperature tested prior to boarding.

Enhance cleaning procedures: We have enhanced our deep cleaning and are using industrial grade cleaning agents as well as increased wipe down of high touch areas onboard.

Hand Sanitiser onboard: Hand sanitiser is now available on every coach and passengers are advised to frequently apply.
