Day 1 Tuesday 10 th February		NEWCASTLE to BALLINA	L - D
Accommodation	Ballina Byron Islander Resort		

8am Depart Kings Coach Depot, you may join the coach at Hexham McDonalds, this morning we head north along the coast through to Port Macquarie where we stop for a relaxing wine tasting and lunch at **Cassegrain Winery**. Cassegrain is a place where passion, heritage, and innovation come together to create exceptional Australian wines.

This afternoon we continue via Coffs Harbour and Grafton, arriving into **Ballina** late afternoon. The northern river region stretches from the mighty Clarence River in the south to Tweed Heads on the Queensland border and west to the foothills of the Great Dividing Range. Three major river valleys traverse the region connecting towns, villages and small communities, each with its own distinctive style and character. The lifestyle is laid back and friendly. Upon arrival we check into our accommodation and freshen up for dinner.

Following breakfast, we travel up the legendary Pacific Coast from laid-back Ballina to vibrant Brisbane. On arrival we enjoy lunch at the Breakfast Creek Hotel. This afternoon we take a guided tour through the renovated **Brisbane Powerhouse** located in New Farm. Discover the history from the late 1920s when the Brisbane Powerhouse supplied electricity for Brisbane's tramway system, to when underground artists, performers and the homeless inhabited the ruins from the 1970's to the early 2000's. The building now holds 1,250 performances and events each year, with a varied program of festivals, visual arts, music, theatre, comedy, dance, film, in-conversation and digital arts. Following our tour, we head to our hotel where we can check-in and unwind for the next 3 nights.

From here we visit to **Ormiston House** – one of the best remaining examples of colonial architecture in Queensland. We enjoy a self-guided tour and a delicious High tea lunch. Leaving here we have the rest of the day at leisure. Tonight dinner is at own arrangements, it is recommended an early dinner before the performance. Tonight, we head to **Brisbane's Suncorp Stadium** for the Royal Edinburgh Tattoo performance. **The Royal Edinburgh Military Tattoo** is a globally celebrated event featuring military and cultural performers. Rooted in centuries-old Scottish tradition, the Tattoo is renowned for showcasing the culture and spirit of Scotland through stirring Massed Pipes and Drums, Highland dance, and vibrant displays of tartan and precision performance. The Brisbane edition marks the exclusive Australian leg of the 75th anniversary milestone show, **The Heroes Who Made Us**, celebrating the Tattoo's rich history and spotlighting local heroes. With over 1,000 performers from around the globe, this once-in-a-lifetime Stadium Spectacular promises to captivate audiences with music, precision drills and cultural performances.
