Day 1 Wednesday 25 March 2026	NEWCASTLE TO HOLBROOK	MT-D

We have arranged a visit to the **Werribee Open Range Zoo**. The zoo has a special focus on African animals so we'll board our special safari bus to take a tour amongst some of the world's iconic grassland animals. We will be completely immersed in the sights, smells and sounds of the savannah as we travel across the Zoo's open plains. The magnificent wildlife, including rhinos, giraffes, zebras and antelopes will seem almost touchable. After our tour we have some free time to enjoy a stroll along the walking tracks to see other animals such as the Meerkats. Departing the zoo we have a short distance to drive to our afternoon visit at the **Werribee Park Mansion**. The mansion has long been regarded as Victoria's finest rural homestead. Completed in 1877 it was built in the Italianate style by pioneering pastoralists, the Chirnside brothers from Scotland. On arrival we will be given an introduction to the mansion before enjoying a **self-guided tour** at our own pace. We also have plenty of time to enjoy the formal gardens including a stroll through the **State Rose Garden**, featuring 4500 plants from 100 species in the shape of a giant Tudor rose.








Day 4 Saturday 28 March 2026	INTERNATIONAL FLOWER SHOW	B-D
