7.30am Depart Kings Depot. Additional pickup points are available at Jesmond, Hexham, East Maitland and Maitland by arrangement at time of booking. Morning tea and comfort stop will be made in the Upper Hunter before we arrive at Dubbo for lunch. After lunch we make our way to the Zoo where we will meet our guide and check into the Zoofari Lodge. The lodges are located near the guest house where you can enjoy a quiet drink before an afternoon Safari Tour. During the tour receive an exclusive look behind the scenes and insight into the animal's personalities thanks to the knowledge of your guide. Dinner tonight will be an African inspired banquet in the Main House.

Set your alarm or just rely on the Zoo's wildlife alarm to wake you up this morning! In the tranquil beauty of sunrise, you will be taken behind the scenes to join the Giraffes as they munch breakfast from your hand, then to the Black Rhino before stopping off at the Asian Elephants. An African inspired breakfast awaits you when you return to the Main House. We will then wave goodbye to the animals and Zoofari Lodge staff and begin our journey into Dubbo for a guided tour of Old Dubbo Gaol. The gaol is a State Heritage listed "must see" that operated for 119 years and representative of powerful, surprising, and dark moments in Australian prison history.

After our tour we make our way to Dubbo RSL Motel for our 2-night stay. After a full day of sightseeing dinner tonight has not been included. This allows for each client to explore the main CBD of Dubbo or visit the Dubbo RSL located next door to the accommodation.

Breakfast in the Motel dining room before we embark on a visit to Shoyoen an authentic, refreshing Japanese garden. The garden features living flowers, fish filled ponds, wooden bridges, a tea hut, four eyed fence (Yotsumegaki) and a magical waterfall. Following our visit to Shoyoen we will enjoy a guided tour of Western Plains Cultural Centre. Listen to the Curator as they walk you through the Gallery and Museum for an immersive tour through the area's history, art collection, and the stories behind the exhibitions at Western Plains Cultural Centre.

Lunch will be in an old historic pub in the centre of Dubbo.

After lunch we will make our way to the Royal Flying Doctor Service Base where you can see the wonderful work of an Australian aviation icon and the newly renovated visitor education centre.

After a full day of sightseeing dinner tonight has not been included. This allows for each client to explore the main CBD of Dubbo or visit the Dubbo RSL located next door to the accommodation.

Established in 1962 with the finest collections of Australiana, this award-winning museum features an array of tools, farm and mining equipment, early photographs and period clothing. Following this we visit the Post Office Hotel for lunch before making our way to the Henry Lawson Centre. Henry Lawson is believed to be one of the best Australian writers and this centre is beautifully dedicated to his life and literary works. After lunch we will continue our journey back to Newcastle with a comfort stop at Denman. Estimated return time to King's Depot is 6pm.
