Welcome to our 5-day tour discovering the **South Coast**.

Sit back and meet your fellow travellers as we head south via the outskirts of Sydney detouring through Stanwell Park so we can cross the **Seacliff Bridge**. This spectacular “coast hugging” bridge is part of what is called the Grand Pacific drive; it links the coastal villages of Coalcliff and Clifton. The bridge itself has become a major attraction because it has been built at the exact point where the Illawarra Escarpment plunges into the South Pacific Ocean, delivering an amazing driving experience. With a guarded shared pathway for pedestrians and cyclists, the bridge offers people a spectacular view of the ocean.

This afternoon we enjoy the **Blue Mile History Tour** which tells the stories of Wollongong's foreshore including our First People's relationship to this land and ocean, Wollongong's colonial history, the creation of the harbour, coal export, sea bathing and salt production. After checking in to the Motel, dinner can be purchased from the Worrigeer Sports Club conveniently located next door.

Today we make our way to the wonderful **Kiama Blowhole**. The famous “Blowhole” which can spurt up to 60 metres high, a perfect spot for a group photo.

After visiting the blowhole we will make our way to the **HARS Aviation Museum**, a world-class aviation museum. The museum has an extensive collection of aircraft, and other aviation memorabilia, that is significant to Australia's aviation heritage.

Lunch today can be purchased in the township of **Berry**. A charming, heritage-filled village on the NSW South Coast known as the first country town south of Sydney. The walkable main street is packed with boutiques, dining, and historic charm.

This afternoon we will return to the Motel where we have some free time to explore the township and boutique shops.

The museum features a world-renowned collection of maritime artefacts and navigational and surveying instruments, the Museum also exhibits a range of nautical equipment, models, photographs, paintings, drawings and objects relating to the history and heritage of the Jervis Bay area.

Dinner tonight can be purchased from the Worrigee Sports Club located next door to the Motel.

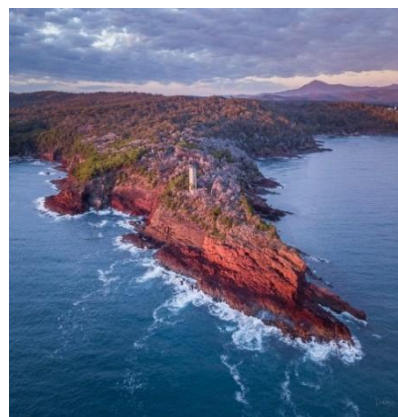
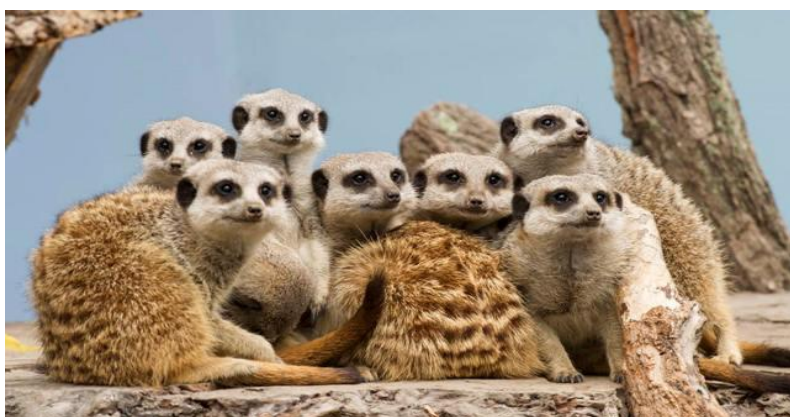
Day 4	MOGO AND BATEMANS BAY	B-L
